Terms of Agreement

Whereby it is agreed as follows:

Purchase Price: The Breeder agrees to sell and the Purchaser agrees to buy the Kitten detailed above at the purchase price of \$_____.

Observed Health: The Purchaser is satisfied with the observed health status of the Kitten at the time of sale.

Registration & Rehoming: The Kitten is registered in the Breeder's name. The registration documents will be forwarded to the Purchaser upon receipt from TICA.

- If the Purchaser wishes to rehome the Kitten for any reason at any point in its life, the Breeder maintains **first refusal**. First refusal means the Purchaser must offer the Kitten to the Breeder first.
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- The Kitten shall not be sold, given away, willed, or donated to any pet shop, shelter, cat rescue, research facility, or third party without the Breeder's prior written consent.
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Indoor Life & Care: The Purchaser agrees to keep the Kitten strictly as an **indoor-only pet** in appropriate conditions for its health and welfare. Due to the trusting nature of Ragdolls, they are unable to defend themselves against outdoors risks, attacks, or theft. The Kitten shall only go outdoors in an appropriate travel carrier for necessary transit (never to walk on a leash, in a stroller, or to play outdoors).

No Declawing: The Purchaser promises **never** to have the Kitten declawed.

Mandatory Veterinary Exam: Purchaser agrees to take the Kitten to a licensed veterinarian within **72 hours** of receipt. Failure to complete a veterinary check within 72 hours constitutes a breach of contract, releasing **Honeys Ragdolls** from any and all financial responsibilities for said Kitten and voiding the Health Guarantee.

Breach of Contract: If any terms of this agreement are breached, or if the Kitten is neglected, maltreated, or fails to receive adequate medical care, the Purchaser agrees to immediately surrender the Kitten to the Breeder unconditionally and without financial compensation. The Purchaser assumes full responsibility for all travel and legal costs incurred if repossession becomes necessary.

Show Potential: If the Kitten is sold with show potential, success in competition cannot be guaranteed.

Vaccinations & Care: The Breeder confirms the Kitten has been examined by a qualified veterinarian and vaccinated to the best of the Breeder's knowledge. Future ongoing care and costs are the sole responsibility of the Purchaser. The Breeder's liability is limited strictly to a replacement kitten as outlined below. **No cash refunds are provided.**

Health Guarantee

Congenital / Hereditary Defects

If the Kitten dies of a congenital defect (excluding disease, accident, or negligence) within the first 12 months of life, **Honeys Ragdolls** will replace the Kitten free of charge with a kitten of comparable quality and value when available. This requires a formal post-mortem/necropsy report from a licensed veterinarian stating the exact cause of death. The Breeder reserves the right to have the report reviewed by their own veterinarian.

General Health

- The Breeder guarantees that the Kitten is free of Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV) and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) at the time of sale.
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- The Kitten has been wormed, vaccinated, and examined by a qualified veterinarian prior to pickup.
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- This health guarantee is valid for **72 hours** post-pickup, provided the Kitten has not had access to the outdoors or other animals.
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- If a qualified veterinarian determines in writing that the Kitten is ill within 72 hours of pickup, the Kitten must be returned to the Breeder within 24 hours. Upon verification by the Breeder's veterinarian (and excluding accidental poisoning or physical injury), the Breeder will replace the Kitten with one of comparable quality when available.
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- *Note:* While **Honeys Ragdolls** tests for genetic diseases, stress from moving can cause dormant conditions or illnesses (e.g., FIP) to surface. After the 72-hour window, **Honeys Ragdolls** is not responsible for non-genetic illnesses, medical bills, or cash refunds.
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Cancellations & Pickups

- The Breeder reserves the right to cancel a sale prior to delivery, in which case all monies paid will be refunded to the Purchaser.
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- If the Purchaser cancels the sale prior to pickup, all monies minus the **\$800 non-refundable deposit** will be refunded. Once a kitten is selected, the deposit is strictly non-refundable and non-transferable.
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- Pickups must occur within **1 week** of notification that the Kitten is ready, unless other arrangements are made in writing. Failure to pick up within the timeframe will be treated as a buyer cancellation.
- **Diet & Transition**

We will inform you of the exact cat food and litter **Honeys Ragdolls** uses. Abruptly changing your Kitten's diet causes severe diarrhea and dehydration. Do not alter their diet until they are fully acclimated to their new home, and do so very gradually.

Transition Guidelines & Acknowledgments

Please read, initial after each section, and sign at the bottom.

1:Carrier & Veterinary Appointment: Please bring a TSA-approved cat carrier to pickup. Once pickup/delivery is arranged, schedule your vet appointment within the mandatory 72-hour timeframe.

2:First Week Home (Stress Control): Leaving familiar surroundings and littermates triggers stress in a kitten's immune system. Please provide a safe, calm environment.

3:Room Isolation (7 Days): Keep your Kitten in a single designated bedroom for their first 7 days. This helps them adjust to food, litter, water, scratching posts, and you. Please ensure someone sleeps in the bedroom with the kitten overnight—do NOT leave them alone.

4:Exploring Beyond the Room: Once the Kitten shows affection and confidence, you may carry them outside the bedroom, but do not let them wander unsupervised. After 7 days, open the bedroom door and let them explore at their own pace while staying nearby.

5:Visitors & Environment: Limit exposure to only household members during the first week. Supervise children at all times, keep them calm around the kitten, and ensure everyone washes their hands prior to handling. Shoes, outside dirt, and unwashed hands introduce viruses and parasites to delicate kittens.

6:Litter Box Setup: Provide an open-tray litter box near the Kitten's bed—tiny bladders wait until the last minute! Do not move the bedroom litter box until the Kitten has completely transitioned. To move a box later, shift it by 1 inch per day. Maintain the rule of **1.5 litter boxes per cat** (e.g., 2 cats = 3 boxes) and scoop twice daily using unscented scoopable litter.

7:Other Pets: Introduce existing dogs or cats only *after* the 7-day period. Allow them to smell each other under the door first. Regularly swap small amounts of litter between boxes during week one to acclimate scent.

8:Fragrance Hazards: Avoid perfumes, air fresheners, plug-ins, essential oil diffusers, fabric softeners, and aerosol sprays. Many are toxic to felines. Clean litter boxes using Dawn Dish Soap and a scrub brush. Ensure all household cleaners are pet-safe and floors are dry before allowing the Kitten to roam.

9:General Household Safety: Provide multiple food/water stations and serve wet food on individual plates. Never feed human food or commercial cat treats (freeze-dried chicken is allowed for older kittens). Check that all house plants and flower arrangements are non-toxic to cats. **Never** brush a cat's teeth with human toothpaste (it is toxic).
